4. Must have resided in Sheridan County a minimum of one year.

Medical Aid:

1. Applicant must have resided in Sheridan County for a minimum of one year and be over the age of one year and under twenty-one years at the time of application.
 2. Each family is to provide the foundation their most recent copy of their Federal Tax Return.
- *ALL MEDICAL AID APPLICATIONS MUST HAVE BOARD APPROVAL PRIOR TO RECEIVING ANY MEDICAL OR DENTAL CARE.*

Mission: The mission of the Cent\$ible Nutrition is to provide educational opportunities for Wyoming families and individuals with limited resources that lead to food security. (Food security is having access to an affordable, available, adequate, nutritious, and safe food supply.) Classes enable participants to develop new skills and gain knowledge to:

- Improve nutritional and physical well-being of the total family
- Increase knowledge of the essentials of human nutrition and physical activity
- Increase the ability to select and buy food that satisfies nutritional needs
- Improve skills in food production, preparation, storage, safety, sanitation, and mealtime practices
- Increase the ability to manage food budgets and related resources such as food stamps

Services Provided: Free nutrition and cooking classes to low-income community members. These classes are designed to help people eat better for less. We offer a series of classes and also do one-time events. We also do classes in qualifying area schools and preschools. (Participants of series receive a free \$20 cookbook and numerous incentives including such items as measuring cups, measuring spoons, cutting board, refrigerator thermometer, jar opener, and sanitizing spray bottle.

- * We also house animals that must be quarantined for rabies observation.
- * We sell and keep track of city dog licenses.
- * We subsidize costs of spaying or neutering companion animals for those owners who cannot afford to pay for the surgeries
- * We sponsor an annual Rabies Clinic.
- * We offer a variety of educational presentations which encourage responsible pet ownership, which in turn contributes toward fewer unwanted animals and fewer animals at large.

Fees: Adoption fees:

All cats available for adoption have been spayed or neutered, microchipped, tested (negative) for leukemia, and given vaccinations proper for their age. Adult cats and kittens over 4 months: \$50; kittens under 4 months: \$65.

All dogs available for adoption have been spayed or neutered, microchipped, and given vaccinations proper for their age. Adult dogs under 20 pounds: \$100; dogs over 20 pounds and puppies over 4 months that will be over 20 pounds when grown: \$50. Puppies under 4 months: \$75.

Population Served: Sheridan County plus surrounding areas in Wyoming and Montana. Most animals that come to the shelter are owned by families rather than individuals. Figuring a minimum of 3 people per family, in 2006 some 1638 people were served when we cared for their lost animals and returned them to them, 2859 were served when we accepted animals they no longer wanted or could keep, and 2781 were served when they found a pet through us, for a total estimate of 7278 people directly benefiting from shelter services. Another 700-1000 benefit annually through the low-cost Rabies clinic. Many others benefit from our public service announcements, monthly radio talk show, tours, and booths at the Cattlewomen's Expo, the high school Health Fair, the County Fair and other events.

Eligibility Requirements: Adoptions: Adopters must be over 18. Animals must be adopted by the people with whom they'll be living. No animals are adopted to one person to be given to another person as a gift.

Surrenders: To surrender an animal, the owner must also be at least 18. They should call first to be sure we have room on that day to receive their pet.

After attending the class, volunteers 12-14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for a month, until they have proved themselves responsible and safe around the animals; after that they may come alone. Volunteers over 14 may come alone after completing the volunteer class and having a parent or guardian sign release papers. Children under 12 must always be accompanied by a parent or guardian who has completed the Volunteer class.

Services include medical prenatal care, prenatal classes, parenting classes, WIC, Medicaid, other financial assistance, home visiting, family planning education, nutritional counseling, post-partum visits, establishing a medical home for newborn, well child care, immunizations and maternal dental health.

WELCOME HOME - Welcome Home is a home visit program offering a free home visit to all parents of a newborn to provide information and support regarding baby care, breast feeding and bottle feeding, community resources, and mom's health issues. Also assessment of baby's general condition and weight.

NURSE-FAMILY PARTNERSHIP - This is a free program for young first-time mothers beginning early in pregnancy and continuing through 2 years of age for baby. The program focuses on positive pregnancy outcomes, supports child health and development, economic self-sufficiency, parenting and life skills.

PREMATURE NEWBORN HOME VISITING - This is a free program for parents with a premature infant (weight less than 4.5 pounds or less than 37 weeks gestation) beginning at discharge from the hospital and continuing through age 2. The program focuses on a smooth transition from hospital to home, feeding and growth issues including breast feeding support, appropriate care giving, both physical and emotional for optimal development as parenting and life skills.

PARENTING CLASSES - 6 week sessions held three times a year on Wednesday mornings from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. Sessions focus on parents of infants and pre-schoolers and are a joint venture with the Child Development Center, Department of Family Services and Community Health.

CHILDREN'S SPECIAL HEALTH SERVICES - Includes financial assistance for high risk pregnant women, high risk newborns, and children with special health care needs from birth to age 19.

DENTAL HEALTH SERVICES - The State of Wyoming provides limited financial assistance for dental care and orthodontia to qualifying persons with crippling malocclusion.

HIV CASE MANAGEMENT - This is a service to individuals living with HIV/AIDS. We help them find services and funding sources, and help coordinate their own care. We also serve as an advocate for clients with bill collectors as well as in the medical system and try to assure the best available care is being provided to the client.

BLOODBORNE PATHOGEN TRAINING - We offer training sessions on Bloodborne Pathogens for business and organizations. Our program meets employers' OSHA mandate for annual employee training, with update for prevention of bloodborne pathogen exposure on the job.

CPR & FIRST AID CLASSES - We offer classes to local businesses needing to certify their employees in CPR & First Aid.

BLOOD PRESSURE CLINIC - Walk-in blood pressure clinics are held every Thursday from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. Information is also available regarding diet and exercise.

ALL HAZARDS RESPONSE PROGRAM - As a member of the Sheridan County Local Emergency Planning Committee, our office plays an active role in developing community plans for the early detection and rapid response to biological or chemical events, infectious disease outbreaks, hazardous material spills and natural disasters.

ADULT HEALTH MAINTENANCE - We provide monitoring and education of health conditions and assessments for adults who are in a stable condition. Aide services may also be provided if necessary. This service is provided in the home, office, clinic setting or classes.
